According to the guidelines issued by the CBSE, Burgess English Hr. Sec. School, Bilaspur has implemented NCERT Text books at all levels of school education. Also to inform that where ever supplementary materials has been implemented, has been done judiciously to provide quality education to its entire pupil. The supplementary materials have been implemented as per requirement which is totally aligned with the NCF-FS and NCF-SE guidelines. The chosen supplementary material aims and contains the essential core material to enhance the learning outputs of students and also to bridge the gap between the learning out comes which has been created due to covid pandemic.

Also to reiterate that the supplementary material has been clubbed with the NCERT text books to increase the understanding and adaptability of the subject by the students. With the introduction of NEP 2020 some of the NCERT text books are still not available in the market. Since the studies of the students are being hampered, some additional supplementary books have been introduced and the implementation is in-accordance and adherence to the recommendation of NCF for school education.



NOTIFICATION

The following amendments have been made in chapter 2, clause 2.4.7 of the Affiliation Bye-Laws 2018, in respect of the rule position on the provisions for use of the textbooks by schools and will come in to force from the date of issue of this notification.

Chapter-2 (2.4.7)				
 a) The School may prescribe NCERT text books in the classes and subjects in which these have been published by 				
the NCERT. Extreme care

b) The school shall put a list of prescribed books on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the Principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the and own the school responsibility. If a school is found prescribing a book having any objectionable content, the responsibility for such content shall lie with the school and action will be initiated against the School by the Board.

Proposed Amended Rule

2.4.7

Classes- I to VIII

- a) Schools are strongly advised to follow NCERT/ SCERT textbooks. Schools may use supplementary material as per their requirement which must be aligned with the NCF-FS and NCF-SB. Such chosen supplementary material must aim to contain the essential core material (together with discussion, analysis, examples, and applications).
 - Classes- IX to XII
- b) Schools shall mandatorily follow the NCERT textbooks prescribed in CBSE curriculum. For subjects in SCERT NCERT/ books are not available. CBSE books uploaded on the website must be followed. Schools can use supplementary material as per their requirement. Use of Digital Content can also be explored to augment the textbooks. The supplementary material and Digital Content used by the school must invariably be aligned with NCF-SE.
- c) Extreme care should be taken while using supplementary material, Digital Content as well as books of private publishers, if so used, so that there is no objectionable content that hurts the feeling of any class, community, gender or any religious group in society.
